FORWARD (YELLOW) TEES

There is still some confusion as to the use of the forward tees (formerly known as senior tees). We trust that the following points will help clear up the misunderstandings:

• The rules with regards to handicaps are NOT Club rules. We subscribe to a national body (HNA) who maintains the current standard. We have seen a few changes over the past few years, and with the new slope rating to be implemented in the next few years we believe a few more changes will be imminent. In the meantime we have a very thick handicapping manual that we use as reference to apply the rules with regards to handicapping.

• In social play any player may play of any tee provided for your specific gender. No permission is needed in order to do so, provided that the player enter his/her score on the same colour tee on the handicapping terminal.

• In competition play no player may play off the forward tees unless approved by the Board. A letter must be submitted before the Board stating the criteria why the player feels the need to make use of this tee (i.e. bad health, age, etc.). Once approved the player will be informed in writing.

• The tees are rated 70(blue), 69 (white) and 68(yellow). The handicapping manual prescribe that the player making use of the forward tee in a club competition must deduct the difference in rating between the yellow tees and the tee that the rest of the field is using off his/her handicap (e.g. 2 strokes should the rest of the field play off blue).

We trust this will be helpful in clearing up all misconceptions.

GRANIET MERKERS

Die reël met betrekking tot die graniet afstand merkers langs die skoonvelde word nog soms deur spelers verkeerd toegepas. Die speler kry nie 'n vry gooi as die merker met die beplande rigting van die hou of met die sig inmeng nie. Verligting sonder strafhou word slegs gegee indien die speler se swaai of staan deur die klip beinvloed word.

Dit is ook verder belangrik om te weet dat geen speler die klip mag uithaal of selfs in die rondte mag draai nie. Die graniet klippe resorteer onder "immovable obstructions" in ons plaaslike reëls en mag dus nie beweeg word nie.

PRIZE-GIVING ATTENDANCE

We announced the Club policy with regards to attendance at prize-giving functions in the newsletter a few weeks ago. The Board felt it necessary to remind members again of the changes to the previous policy.

The nomination of players by prize-winners did not have the desired effect for the Club as well as the sponsors. The Board felt the need to make attendance at these functions compulsory to respect the effort put in by both sponsors and the Club to put decent prizes on the table. We are aware that some of our members travel a long distance to play golf, and some have alternative working arrangements. This may prevent them from attending the function. The policy allows for these circumstances, provided they are discussed on the day with either the Club Manager or the Board member on duty that day. ONLY players who play in the morning field will be phoned to inform them should they be in the prizes. The co-operation of members in this regard will be sincerely appreciated.

ON THE COURSE

• Let asb op dat die area tussen 10 en 11 wat tradisioneel as GUR gemerk was, vanaf 1 April nie meer as GUR gemerk sal wees nie. Die area sal dan as normale rof beskou word met die normale reëls wat dan geld.

Please note that the area between 10 and 11 have been satisfactorily rehabilitated. Effective 1 April, this area will no longer be treated as GUR, and therefore the normal rules for rough will apply.

On the left of the 18th hole a member of the Golf Estate erected a temporary building fence breaching the out of bounds line. If this fence interferes with your stance or swing the player will be allowed to drop.
